

# THE STUART YOUNG AWARDS

The Stuart Young Awards commemorate the life and achievements of an outstanding member of the Anglo-Jewish community, who made significant contributions in the fields of accountancy, communications and business, and also in voluntary social services.

The Trustees seek to aid students, during their years at University, who have academic merit, financial need and who, in the judgement of the Trustees, are likely to contribute subsequently to the wellbeing of the Jewish and wider communities.

Head Teachers are invited to nominate candidates for an Award of £2,000 per annum for three years, to students in Year 13 going up to University. Candidates with deferred places are not normally eligible but should apply in the year of entry to University. The Award will begin upon the student taking up his or her place, and may continue for a maximum of three years.

Head Teachers of both independent and state schools are asked to nominate only those students whose families are likely to incur serious financial difficulties in supporting their children through their years in Higher Education. The continuation of the Award each year is dependent upon satisfactory reports from the University.

Students are required to complete the form and submit a general letter of application, setting out their principal interests, their achievements to date in school, their contributions to the Jewish and local communities, and their aspirations for the future (maximum 750 words).

# Stuart Young Scholarships 2010

## How to apply?

The following documents should be returned via the Head Teacher or Head of Sixth Form to **Julia Samuel, Stuart Young Awards, Haskell House, 152 West End Lane, London NW6 1SD** prior to **30 April 2010**.

1. The application form completed by the pupil.
2. A Curriculum Vitae (C.V.).
3. A Personal Statement of no more than 750 words which should include:
  - i. your reasons for taking the proposed course;
  - ii. your career aspirations, if known;
  - iii. your reasons for being considered for a Stuart Young Scholarship and if awarded, how it would impact on your life.
4. A confidential recommendation from the Head Teacher (or Head of 6th Form) which must include statements indicating that, in the opinion of the Head, the applicant has the ability to successfully complete the proposed course and that to the Head's knowledge the applicant will suffer severe financial hardship without the offer of a Scholarship of the type proposed by the Stuart Young Award Scheme.
5. A second reference from a social worker, teacher or similar professional. This should be sent separately if not available.

Please ensure that all applications and statements (single sheets not double sided) are completed on A4 paper in black ink or typed.

A copy of the university letter of acceptance will be required in due course.

### **Parents' Confidential Statement**

So that as full an assessment as possible of the applicant's financial position is made a statement of income should be completed by the parents, parents representatives or guardians of the applicant and should be returned directly to Julia Samuel at the above address.
